Supplication of the Month :: Supplication of the debt

On the authority of Abu Waail on the authority of 'Ali Ibn Abi Taalib (RadiAllaahu 'Anhu) that someone who was indebted came to him and said: I am unable to pay my debt so help me, he said: Shall I not teach you a few words the Messenger of Allaah (Sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) taught me, if you had the like of mountain (Seerin) of debt Allaah would fulfill it on your behalf? Sa: "Allaahummakfinee bihalaa'lika 'an haraamik, wa aghninee bifadlika 'amman siwak"

O my Allah make me with that You have made lawful needless of what You have made unlawful, and make me with your benevolence independent of all others.
