Important Question: There are some groups who claim that it is legitimate to target any Non-Muslim civilians and kill them wherever they are found. They claim that it is a legitimate and rather it is an act of heroism and those who perform these kinds of assassination attempts are truly serving Islam and the religion of Allaah. They say “we can kill the American civilians because they kill many Muslims and civilians amongst Muslims (they refer to casualty of the war of Iraq and other places). Is this correct understanding?

Answer: **This is not a correct understanding** but rather this is a deviant methodology because in their argument they say “the kuffar kill us, so we can kill the kuffar.” In their statement, they refute themselves. When they say we kill kuffar because they kill us, they are saying they are taking the kuffar as their example. Allaah commands us to follow and take Mohammad (sallallaahu ‘alayhi wa sallam) as our example. So, when we look into the Sunnah we see that the Prophet (sallallaahu ‘alayhi wa sallam) strictly forbade to kill civilians and non-combatants even in a legitimate ware-fare. So, the prophet’s war-fare was based upon fairness and just rule. We ask these criminals, did the Prophet (sallallaahu ‘alayhi wa sallam) indiscriminately kill everyone who opposed him, their children, their women, their friends? Rather, numerous times, he forgave them, was patient with them and only took care of certain individuals when it was absolutely necessary.

These deviant groups who are issuing demand of attacking any and every target have nothing but emotion in their heart and they misunderstand or intentionally twist the words of Allaah to justify their act of terror and horror.

As true Muslims, we shouldn’t break our oath and pledges we make. When the Muslims are living or entering United States of America, they are entering this country upon a pledge that they will not harm their citizens and will abide by their laws. If anyone doesn’t wish to stay in America or are unhappy with their foreign policy, they can voice their opinion in the land of free speech but they can’t and shouldn’t plot to carry assassination attempts against any Americans claiming they are infidels and hence can be killed.

Below are some ahadith that shows the forbiddance of breaking pledges and commitments. Under no circumstances, it is allowed for Muslims to engage

themselves in shooting, bombing buildings and killing innocent lives of citizens of this country.

Abu Hurairah (May Allah be pleased with him) reported: Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "Three are the signs of a hypocrite: When he speaks, he lies; when he makes a promise, he breaks it; and when he is trusted, he betrays his trust." [Al-Bukhari and Muslim]. Another narration adds the words: "Even if he observes Saum (fasts), performs Salat (prayer) and claims to be a Muslim."

Narrated Anas: The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "Every betrayer will have a flag on the Day of Resurrection" One of the two sub narrators said that the flag would be fixed, and the other said that it would be shown on the Day of Resurrection, so that the betrayer might be recognized by it. [Al-Bukhari]

Narrated Anas bin Malik: Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said, "Whoever prays like us and faces our Qibla and eats our slaughtered animals is a Muslim and is under Allah's and His Apostle's protection. So do not betray Allah by betraying those who are in His protection." [Al-Bukhari]
