Sunnah of the month (Etiquette of Supplication – Part 3)

We are continuing with the etiquette of supplication based on the work of the esteemed Sheikh Husayn Al-'Awaishah (May Allaah preserve him) titled "Kitaabud-du'a."

16. One can raise both the hands: Al-Bukhari reported that Ibn 'Umar said: "The Prophet (sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) raised his hand and said: "O Allaah! I declare my innocence of what Khalid has done."

Al-Bukhari also reported from Musa who said, "The Prophet (sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) made du'a and he raised his hands until I saw the whiteness of his underarm." Hafiz Ibn hajr said in his "Fath-Al-Bari" "there are many traditions in favor of raising hands in du'a. Al-Mundhiri has collected them in separate booklet and An-Nawawi has cited some of them in his book: "Al-Adhkar" and "Sharh A-Muhadhdhab" and Bukhari wrote a chapter about it in "Al-Adab Al-Mufrad."

17. It is recommended to have ablution: Abu Musa reported, "When the Prophet (sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) had finished from the battle of Hunayn he sent Abu 'Amir to lead an army to Awta, and he sent me with him. Abu 'Amir was struck by an arrow which the man from Jusham had shot and it lodged in his knee. I removed it, and water oozed out of it. He said, "O som of my brother, convey my greetings to the Prophet (sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) and request him to ask Allaah's forgiveness for me." He survived for a short while then died. I returned and called on the Prophet (Sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) at his home, and found him lying in a bed made of the stalks of date-palm leaves knitted with ropes and on it there was bedding. The strings of the bed had left their marks on this back and sides. I told him about our and Abu 'Amir's news, and his request (to tell him to ask Allaah's forgiveness for him). The Prophet asked for water, performed ablution, and raised his hands saying, "O Allaah! Forgive your servant Abu 'Amir." I saw the whiteness of the Prophet's underarm. He continued, "O Allaah, make himon the Day of Resurrection superior to many of your human creatures." I said, "Would you ask Allaah's forgiveness for me as well?" He said, "O Allaah, forgive the sins of 'Abdullaah ibn Qays and admit him to a nice entrance on the Day of Resurrection?" [Al-Bukhari and Muslim reported it, the text of it is from "sharh As-Sunnah" of Al-Baghawi as authenticated by Sheikh Shuaib Al-Arnaout]

18. Crvng when making du'a: 'Abdullaah Ibn 'Amr ibn Al-'Aas reported that "the Prophet (sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) recited the words of Allaah about Ibrahim ('alayhis-salaam): <O my Lord, they have indeed led astray many among mankind. He then who follow my ways is of me.> and 'Isaa's saying: <If You punish them they are Your servants, but You forgive them verily You are the Exalted, the Wise.> Then he (Sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) raised his hands and said, "O Allaah, my community, my community, and he cried. Allaah said: "O Jibreel! Go to Mohammad and your Lord knows better and ask him what makes him cry." Jibreel came to the Messenger of Allaah (Sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) and asked him. The Prophet (sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) told him about his concern for his community. Jibreel returned to Allaah Almighty and informed him while Allaah knew everything. Allaah the Most Hight said, "O Jibreel, go to Muhammad and tell him that: We shall please you concerning your community, and shall not cause you to be unhappy. [reported by Muslim]

19. One should show the need for Allaah's help, and implore Him for release from weakness, hardship and tribulations: Allaah the Exalted said about Ya'qub: An Ya'qub when he cried to his lord, "truly distress has seized me, and You are the Most Merciful of those who are Merciful. [21:83]

Supplication of the month

Abu Hurayrah reported that the Prophet (sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) said: one who says when he goes to his bed,

"Laa Ilaaha Illallaah, Wahdahu Laa Sharika lah, Lahul Mulk, walahul Hamd, Wa huwa 'Alaa Kulli Shayin Qadeer, Wa laa hawla wa laa quwwata illaa billaah, subhanAllaah, walhamdulillaah, wa laa ilaahaa illallaahu wallaahu Akbar"

his sins [or his mistakes, one of the narrators had doubt] will be forgiven even it is in the amount of the foam on the ocean.

[Translation of the du'a: **There is no ilaah except Allaah, One without any partner, to Him belongs the dominion, and all Praise, and He is capable of everything, there is no power and strength other than Him, glorified be He, All Praise be to Him, There is no Ilaah except Him and He is the Greatest!**]

[Ibn Hibban recorded it in his saheeh, Ibn As-Sunnee in his "Amal Al-Yawm Wal-laylah" and Abu Nu'aym in "Akhbaar As-bahan" in authority of Mis'ar bin Kidaam 'an Habeeb Ibn Abee Thabit 'an 'Abdullaah ibn Baabaah 'an Abee Hurayrah 'an An-Nabiyy sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam, see Silsilatul Ahaadith-as-saheehah 3414 of Sheikh Mohammad Naasiruddin Al-Albaani]
