## Isra wal me'raj – part Two

- He saw Musa, Isaa, Ibrahim praying in Masjid Al Aqsa too. He described all three of them. Musa as tall like the people of Azd Shanua, dark complexion, Isaa as medium height, well built and in one narration red

complexion as if he came out from the hammam! And described Ibrahim as a copy of himself (sallallaahu ‘alayhi wa sallam).

- Then the time of prayer was called and he led the prophets and messenger in prayer
- Then Angel Jibreel took him with his hand raised above the sky to the lowest heaven.
- Jibreel asked the door to be opened, the angel asked him who it was and who was with him and if he [i.e. the prophet] was sent for. Jibreel answered that he was Jibreel and with him was Mohammad and Mohammad [‘alayhis-salaam] was sent for and the angel welcomed them in the first heaven. And said what a blessed entry it was!
- And this is how Jibreel took him through all the seven heavens.
- In each heaven the prophet met certain Prophet and Messenger and he asked Angel Jibreel who it was and angel Jibreel introduced him to the specific prophet(s) and told him to give them salam. The prophet gave them salam and they answered the salam and said good things to him. They said *مَرْحَبًا بِالنَّبِيِّ الصَّالِحِ وَالْأَخِ الصَّالِحِ* [welcome O righteous prophet, and righteous brother] except Adam and Ibrahim who said: *مَرْحَبًا بِالنَّبِيِّ الصَّالِحِ وَالْإِبْنِ الصَّالِحِ* [welcome O righteous Propht, O righteous son] . For Adam and Ibrahim, Jibreel introduced them as his father and then mentioned their names! For others, Jibreel introduced them by name only
- In the first heaven he saw Prophet Adam. He saw on his right many people and left many people and when he looked right he smiled and when he looked left he wept. And angel Jibreel explained the reason, which is on his right are children who are destined for paradise and on the left side are the people of hell, so when looked on the right he smiled and when he looked on the left he wept!
- In the second heaven he met Isaa and Yahya the maternal cousins.
- In the third heaven he met Yusuf. And the Prophet explained Yusuf was given half of beauty

- In the fourth heaven he met Idris. And the prophet recited the verse “warafahu makaanan ‘alaiyyah” [And we raised him on high place]
- In the fifth heaven he met Haaron
- In the sixth heaven he met Musa and when he was leaving, Musa wept and when he was asked why he is weeping, he said:  
 فَلَمَّا تَجَاوَزْتُ بَنِي، قِيلَ لَهُ مَا يُبْكِيكَ قَالَ أَبُيكَ لِأَنَّ غُلَامًا بُعِثَ بَعْدِي، يَدْخُلُ الْجَنَّةَ مِنْ أُمَّتِهِ أَكْثَرَ مَنْ يَدْخُلُهَا مِنْ أُمَّتِي I am weeping because I see a young man who sent after me will enter Jannah and his nation is larger in number than my nation.
- In the seventh heaven he met Ibrahim reclining on the side of baytul Ma’mur. The prophet was explained that this house, every day 70 thousand angels enter to pray and once they leave they never come back.
- After that angel Jibreel high and the prophet heard the scraping of the pen
- ثُمَّ عَرَجَ بِي حَتَّى طَهَّرْتُ لِمُسْتَوَى أَسْمَعُ فِيهِ صَرِيْفَ الْأَقْلَامِ .
- The prophet saw Malik the angel in charge of Hell and Jibreel told him to give him salam but Malik first gave salam to the Prophet
- The Prophet also saw Dajjal
- The prophet saw paradise and entered paradise. And he saw hell and was shown shajarat-zaqquq
- He saw two types of people punished [those who destroy people’s honor and the khutabah of this ummah who don’t do what they preach].
