## WHY IS THE DA'WAH OF ISIS SPREADING?<sup>1</sup>

Question:

There are fatāwa from the 'Ulama today, but ISIS still has a strong presence. It is like it is the opposite today, why is this?

## Answer from Shaykh 'AbdulMalik ar-Ramadānī:

Correct, in any case this will change insha'Allaah, it will not remain like this. However, the problem is, as I said to you, the activity of ISIS is major while the activity of those opposing them is considered to be weak. This is the reason, this is why I said to you before: states and countries have to increase their efforts, [for example], print 3 million copies of such and such book, 4 million copies of this book, and distribute them, give them out. Why is this not to be found? Is this found in the Islamic countries today? Unfortunately it is not happening, very weak. Why is this not to be found? It is not possible for the Islamic states to fight against a misguided ideology except with a clean one.
